

The Three Rivers Bike Tour

Parc d'Oka to Long Sault (108 km)

0	0	Back to the Oka Ferry on Route Verte #1.
3.5	3.5	Oka Ferry. (\$2/person with bike)
0	3.5	After the ferry, turn RIGHT at the stop sign on to Chemin de l'Anse.
4.8	8.3	In Hudson, turn LEFT at Côte St. Charles.
2.3	10.6	Straight ahead at Rte. Harwood (Hwy. #342). Start of a bike path that runs for 2.6 km.
4.9	15.5	Turn RIGHT on to Chemin St. Angélique. This is horse country, so watch out for riders crossing over the road!
3.8	19.3	T-Junction. Turn LEFT on to highway #201.
1.2	20.5	Turn RIGHT on to Chemin St. Guillaume.
4.4	24.9	In Sainte Marthe, turn LEFT (opposite the church) on to Mtée. Ste. Marie.
2.3	27.2	Straight ahead on to Mtée. Ste. Julie
2.7	29.9	Turn RIGHT on to Chemin du 3ème Rang (be careful – this junction can be confusing!).
3.3	33.2	Turn LEFT on to Mtée. Bertrand
1.4	34.6	Turn RIGHT on to Chemin du 4ème Rang (Fourth Line)
5.6	40.2	Ste. Justine Station. Turn LEFT on to highway #325, Mtée de la Station.
8.5	48.7	St Téléphore. Turn RIGHT on to Highway #340.
2.6	51.3	Back in Ontario! Quebec Highway #340 becomes C.R. #18, which you follow all the way to St. Andrews.
34.3	85.6	St. Andrews. Straight ahead on C.R. 18 at Highway #138.
2.3	87.9	Take the LEFT fork on to C.R. 36.
6.2	94.1	Turn LEFT on C.R. 15.
1.0	95.1	C.R. 2. Cross C.R. 2 and you will find the St. Lawrence Recreational Path, a paved bike path, on the south (river) side. Turn RIGHT on to the bike path.
4.0	99.1	Turn LEFT on to the Long Sault Parkway (bike path ends).
9.0	108.1	Turn LEFT into McClaren Campsite.
